

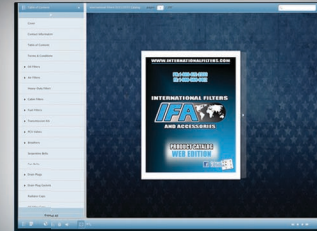


IFA Online Catalog Instructions -

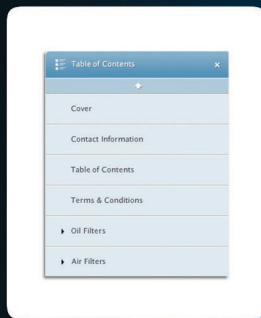
STEP 1: Compatibility

Upon clicking the banner or any other link to the catalog on our site, the application should load and appear like the image shown on the right

This application will work with all of the supported browsers below and if you experience any problems, please upgrade to the latest version of your browser before further troubleshooting



STEP 2: Table of Contents Sidebar



The catalog will open by default with the table of contents sidebar on the left hand of the screen

Once you click the IFA 2011/2012 Catalog title side arrow, it will reveal all of the categories as a drop down that you can then navigate.

There are up and down arrows as well on the table of contents section that allow you to navigate categories easily once you start to expand each product area



Note: If your mouse has a scroll wheel, you can scroll up and down through categories easily as long as your cursor is placed in the table of contents section

STEP 3: Understanding the Catalog Buttons

Table of contents button makes the T.O.C. appear/disappear

Select text to copy from the catalog pages

Fullscreen Mode - Note that the search feature does not work while in fullscreen

Zoom in/out button

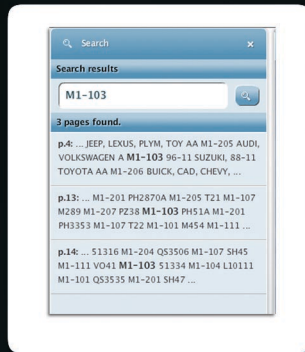
Thumbnails button shows all pages in the catalog as small thumbnails in the sidebar

STEP 4: Understanding the Search Function



Search results will show what pages the term appears on starting with the earliest page it appears on.



The search bar in this catalog is in the top right of the application

Any sort of product title is searchable. For example: If you Type M1-103 and hit enter or press the search button, the corresponding results will show on the left sidebar

Note: The more specific your search term is, the better results you will yield

STEP 5: Additional Catalog Features

ZOOM

The zoom function works in two ways - Double Clicking will zoom in the page you have your cursor on. Double clicking again will zoom back out.

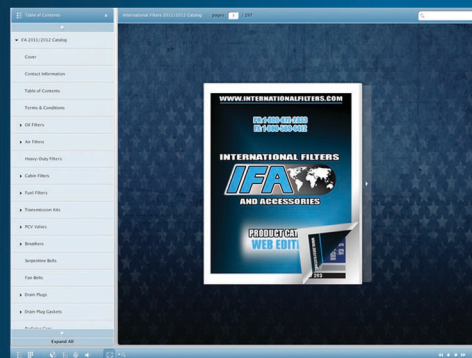


Once you zoom in, the slider will appear below the enlarged page. You can then use your cursor to drag the page around and then use the slider to zoom further if necessary

PAGE TURNING

You can turn the pages simply by clicking and holding either the top or bottom of the page until it curls and then dragging the page across the screen

The large right and left arrow tabs that appear on both sides of the pages can be used as well to turn forward or backwards



You can also use the page scroller in the lower right corner to navigate to the previous or following page.

The outer arrows take you to the first page and last page of the catalog

QUICK PAGE SCROLLING



When the catalog is opened, the bulk pages appear on the right or left depending on far into the publication you may be.

If you place your cursor on the white space, the corresponding page number will appear and you can then click to be quickly forwarded to that numbered page
